	Prepare a preliminary guest list and compile addresses.			
	Determine your transportation and accommodation requirements.			
	Set your wedding date and inspect the ceremony and reception venue(s).			
	Determine the persons you would like to be assisted by.			
	Determine the places you will be purchasing your bridal gown and accessories, veil and shoes.			
	Set your wedding date with the municipality and prepare the necessary paperwork.			
	Book your venue.			
	Choose the wedding cake.			
	Decide on your flowers and decor.			
	Book a photographer and videographer.			
	Choose your ceremony, first dance and cake ceremony music.			
	Arrange transportation for the wedding day.			
	Order wedding invitations.			
	If you would like to use one, research and find a professional calligrapher.			
	Purchase your wedding bands.			
	Determine the groom's tuxedo.			
	Purchase the rest of the bridal accessories.			
	Decide on your hairdresser and makeup artist.			
	Order the wedding sweets and favours.			
	Plan your Honeymoon and book your accommodations.			
	If necessary, start taking dance classes.

	Do a bridal gown rehearsal with your accessories.			
	Book a hair and makeup rehearsal with your veil.			
	Purchase a guestbook/album.			
	Prepare the seating plan and determine your confirmed head count.			
	Give the organization company your confirmed head count.			
	Call guests who have not yet sent in their RSVP.			
	Pick up your bridal gown and tuxedo.			
	Test your wedding dinner.			
	Pack for your honeymoon.			
	Determine your bridesmaid and bestman.			
	Confirm all transportation arrangements.			
	Put all the ceremony-related accessories, such as favours, wedding band boxes and guestbook in a box to be taken to the venue.			
	Do a ceremony rehearsal.			
	Assign and authorize a friend for your wedding day organization and share all the flow with her/him.
